





Installation


1.The center of the mounting hole to the edge of the basin and to the edge of the wall should be at least 30-40 mm (1.18-1.57"). Otherwise the mounting nut would not fit. Ensure a proper sensing distance.




Installation location to be decided by the site owner.

2.Drill a hole (size:35 mm/ 1.37") on the basin.


- 3. Mounting steps of the spout:
- A. Insert the shaft of the spout through the hole on the basin.
- B. Thread in the rubber pad, the stainless steel washer, and the plastic mounting nut.
- C. Fasten with the hex tool.





4.With the arrow on the side of the solenoid pointing up, as shown, fasten the water outlet hose with the top connector.












Installation



Installation Height

Recommended mounting height: Please install it based on the height of deck on-site. Recommended deck thickness: 10-30 mm (0.39-1.18")

Operation

- No-touch operation.
- Place hands under the faucet.
- Once the sensor is activated, water will flow automatically.
- Once hands leave the sensing range, water will stop flowing automatically.

Cleaning and Maintenance

Periodic cleaning of the unit is recommended to ensure optimal performance.

- Disconnect the electrical supply.
- · Do not flush with water.
- Wipe the cover with a damp cloth and mild cleaning solution. Do not soak. Never use abrasives to clean the cover.
- Clean the filter every three months to make sure the outlet is free from obstruction.








Diagnostics and Remedies

Malfunction Situation	Potential Reasons of Malfunction	Troubleshooting
No Function and there is No LED when hands are in the sensing range	The power is not connected.	Examine the power supply with multimeter to check power connector.
	Electric circuit board is damaged.	Please contact the distributor for assistance.
	Adapter is out of order.	Replace a new adapter.
No Function but the LED is steady blue when hands are in the sensing range	Water supply is not turned on.	Turn on the water supply.
	Solenoid valve terminal is loose.	Reconnect solenoid valve terminal.
	Solenoid valve failure.	Replace a new solenoid valve set.
Water runs nonstop after 60 seconds	There is dirt on the sensor window.	Clean the sensor window with neutral cleaning solution.
	Solenoid valve failure.	Replace a new solenoid valve set.
Water runs without use	There is dirt on the sensor window.	Wipe the sensor window with neutral cleaning solution.
Unstable water flow	Electric circuit board is damaged.	Please contact the distributor for assistance.
Reduced water volume	Water supply is low.	Regulate the valve to increase the water supply.
	Filter of solenoid valve is clogged.	Clean the filter of solenoid valve.
	Aerator is clogged.	Clean impurities from the aerator.
LED board is damaged	Electric circuit board is damaged.	Please contact the distributor for assistance.
